

Startup Bootcamp, focused on providing participants with the frameworks for understanding, validating and developing viable business concepts. It concludes with a public pitch competition. This year included a partnership with Maquoketa High School to grow participation and time for innovation.

Wednesdays are Possible, a monthly community conversation to interview local founders and learn about their journeys toward business success. Founders have included Maquoketa Brewing's Mark Lyon, and David Blake of nationally acclaimed pet products company Blue-9.

Summer Science Camp, we know that success begins early, so we launched a 3 week series of science camps for elementary and middle school students Two years of camp enrollment filled up quickly.


